

## **Professional Writing Tutoring**



- Professional writing tutors have graduate degrees in writing-intensive disciplines
- Receive expert help with any assignment, at any stage of the writing process, from brainstorming to outlining to editing
- O 30 or 60 minute one-on-one appointments
  - You must make an appointment ahead of time unless attending a drop-in workshop
- Tutors can help you bounce ideas off someone with writing expertise, learn new writing strategies, and see your writing from a new perspective

- Supportive: Remember, we will prioritize skills to help you be successful on your own.



 Expertise in success in a discipline (study habits, networking advice)


