Notes: Maintaining Your Honors Status

- ï 4 Honors general education courses + 4 Honors courses in the major (Some transfer honors credits accepted)
- ï Honors students must maintain a 3.25 Cumulative GPA
- ï In order to earn Honors credit for a course, Students must earn at least a C+ in the course.
- ï All Honors coursework appears on the transcript.
- ï 80 hours of required co-curricular activity (4 Cornerstones x 20 hours of engagement per Cornerstone = 80 hours)
- ï ALL HONORS COURSEWORK MUST BE COMPLETED DURING THE UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE PROGRAM
