2022-2023 ALUMNI DEMOGRAPHIC REPORT

Over the cycle of 2022-2023, in particular, September through November, **17 alumni** have completed a **2021-2023 Community and Trauma Counseling (CTC) Alumni Demographic Survey**.

- Of these individuals, 11 (64.71%) identified as someone with an age range of 25 – 34, 2 (11.76%) individuals with an age range of 35 – 44, another 2 individuals with an age range of 45-54, and 1 individual with an age range of 55-64.
- 64.71% identified as White, Black or African American (23.53%), and other (2%).
- 88.24% identified as female, male (0%), transgender (5.88%), and other (5.88%).
- The alumni varied in professional identity in counseling related to current employment that 47.06% reported as *community agency counselor*, 29.41% as counselors working in *private practice*, and 23.53% reported as *other*.
- Additionally, in relation to current income from counseling activities per year, 13 of the sample of 17 respondents have responded: 30.77% for \$40,000-\$49,000; 23.08% for \$50,000-\$59,000, and 15.38% for \$60,000-\$69,000; 7.69% for \$70,000-\$79,000; 7.69% for \$80,000-\$89,000;
