Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing

The Office of Supportive Housing's (OSH) prevention services include housing stabilization and cash assistance with rent, utilities, and security deposits to households city-wide to resolve a housing crisis and prevent homelessness.

Homeless Centralized Intake Services sites:

- Apple Tree Family Center – for single females/Males and families – 1430 Cherry Street 7 am – 3 pm
- The Red Shield – after-hours reception for families – 715 N Broad Street after 3 pm
- Station House – after-hours reception 2601 N. Broad Street after 3 pm
- Ridge Center – intake and after-hours reception for single males – 1360 Ridge Avenue.
