## PCA Caregiver Support Program (CSP)

The PCA Caregiver Support Program helps older Philadelphians and those who care for them find the services and resources they need.

The program provides a wide array of resources for these unpaid primary caregivers, including education and training, financial assistance, referrals, and more.

Services and supports available through the Caregiver Support Program include:

- Care management to evaluate caregiver's needs and goals, develop an individualized support plan, connect caregiver to services and monitor progress
- Financial assistance to reimburse caregiving services and supplies, including medical supplies; home modifications; personal care; adult day care; and emotional, legal, and financial counseling.
- Education and training to enhance caregiving skills while alleviating stress associated with caregiving
- Information and referral to access caregiving services and support, including adult daycare centers and home health aide services
- Benefits counseling for caregivers receiving support from income-based programs

### Caregiver Eligibility:

- Age 60-plus OR
- Age 18-plus with a diagnosis of disability OR
- A person of any age with dementia
- AND require assistance with at least one activity of daily living (ADL)
- The caregiver must provide routine assistance
