Homelessness Prevention and Transitional Housing

Project HOME is an organization that provides housing, opportunities for employment, medical care, and education to homeless and low-income persons in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.

Project HOME's Outreach Coordination Center (OCC) oversees all outreach to people living on the streets of Philadelphia. Response workers attempt to build long-term, trusting relationships with people experiencing homelessness and gradually lead them toward seeking help.

Project HOME provides a range of supportive housing for all phases of recovery including safe havens, transitional housing, and permanent supportive housing. The level of supportive services, such as case management and on-site medical care, varies based on individual needs.
